My own grandchildren are fortunate in this respect in that they have parents, both of whom are teachers and as they live in London have been introduced from a very early age to a wide variety of experiences denied to their counterparts in more remote areas. In Cornwall where there are many isolated towns and villages it is both expensive and time consuming to give children a breadth of experience of the world. Television is no substitute. Actually visiting a centre for the homeless,(as young people on the programme have done),and listening to a first hand account of what it means to be without shelter brings home the reality of the world in a way that no radio or TV programme can.

As Patron of the programme I am proud to be associated with a scheme that frankly is streets ahead of activities in other parts of the country. This is due to the imagination and flair of the leaders of the course and also to those business firms who have had the foresight to sponsor the programme.

If you are new to Citizenship may I encourage you to find out more and see if you can play some role in helping the young people of Cornwall have opportunities for the future. Not only is this programme in the best interests of Cornwall. It is vital to the development of the UK as we all move into a new and exciting era.

BACKGROUND

Our mission is to enable young people with significant personal challenges to develop their confidence and skills through an inspirational journey of learning, thereby enabling them to grow both as individuals and good citizens.

Citizenship for Life (C4L) has a strong track record of over a decade of delivery of high-quality support and motivation to young people aged 12-15 years who are based in Cornwall.

We have always targeted mentees who will gain most from the experience. We recruit a volunteer mentor for each of the young people, who we draw from the local business community and third sector.

We deliver a motivational 12-month journey of learning/activities and in so doing, take them to places and spaces that will broaden their horizons and enable them to meet inspirational people who have made their mark on society and who can share their lived experiences.

The focus is on encouraging our young people to become better citizens, but we also recognise their needs, to ensure that they are building their emotional resilience to help others, as well as caring for themselves.





Citizenship for Life is about to embark on its 15th year in Cornwall.

In association with the local business community, local Rotary Clubs, Parish and Town Councils and other public and private sector organisations, the programme will run for twelve months from June 2024 until May 2025 and will involve the young people in a variety of real life experiences that neither their school nor parents are able to provide, but which we believe will provide them the knowledge and skills they need to understand how the educational and lifestyle choices they make will affect their future prospects and opportunities.

We are confident that, given our track record, we can keep the lights of Citizenship for Life burning brightly for the next three years as a minimum with our dedicated team of volunteers, supporters and stakeholders.



OBJECTIVES

- Develop and improve social and personal skills
- √ Help improve self-esteem and self-confidence by inspiring participants to go outside their comfort zones
- Develop an understanding of entrepreneurship and social enterprise
- \checkmark Help prepare participants for the world of work and so enhance employability skills
- Provide an inspirational learning environment where they want to succeed and improve future prospects
- Provide a broader understanding of the world around them and greater knowledge of local, regional, national and international issues
- Create an understanding of the impact of educational and lifestyle choices and how they can affect future prospects
- Offer an insight into the work of partner organisations and local businesses and offer work experience and community project opportunities
- ✓ Understand sustainability and environmental responsibility



The Citizenship for Life team are delighted that you are interested in getting involved in the Citizenship for Life programme.

There are three main ways to get involved:

- 1. Mentoring Members of the local community who give up their time to mentor a young person
- 2. Supporting 'In-kind' support received from individuals, businesses and organisations
- 3. Sponsoring Financial support from individuals, businesses and organisations to fund the core running costs of the programme.

MENTORING

Mentoring is an extremely effective way of providing guidance and support to young people in need and it is a proven way of aiding social mobility by encouraging and enabling local communities to work together.

The mentoring scheme on the Citizenship for Life programme was created in order to utilise the skills, experience and knowledge of the local community, to raise the ambitions and attainment of those young people who need it the most. Each participant on the Citizenship for Life programme is paired with a one-to-one mentor who has been selectively handpicked onto the programme to:

- Be a positive role model for a young person in need
- Be a person that their mentee can trust and confide in
- Assist their mentee by helping to raise their confidence and self-esteem
- ✓ Be a pillar of support for their mentee throughout the programme on each of the visits
- Assist their mentee by offering good advice and contacts where necessary
- √ Offer support in any tasks set on the programme

The role of the mentor is crucial to the development of the participants on the programme but it has also proven to be a very rewarding scheme for the mentors themselves too.

If you believe that you would make a good mentor for a young person in Cornwall, or you know somebody else that would be, then the following steps explain the Citizenship for Life mentoring process in a nutshell:

- 1. Request an application form, complete and return by the deadline
- 2. Attend a small panel interview with C4L Directors
- 3. Attend a pre-programme training and preparation day
- 4. Attend the twelve monthly excursions with your mentee
- 5. There may be a number of other interval events that the mentors will be asked to attend such as mentor review sessions, celebration events, social gatherings, etc

SUPPORTING



The Citizenship for Life programme costs approximately £35,000 to run each year.
